

10 IDEAS OF ACTIVITIES AND INITIATIVES TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND GIRLS

- 1 Boycott products/magazines/websites/music that use sexist abusive portrayal of women.
- 2 Launch a campaign targeting men and boys and encourage them to stand up for gender equality and break down the attitudes that cause violence against girls and women.
- 3 Organise awareness-raising sessions or community dialogues about Violence against women and girls and explain its extent, severity, and consequences. This brings awareness to the issue, motivates others to act and accumulates broader social support for the criminalization of VAWG.
- 4 Organise a hackathon to address the challenge of domestic violence by building innovative technology solutions to assist the victims of Violence Against Women and the agencies and organizations that work to support them.
- 5 Organise an art exhibition to raise awareness about violence against women and girls.
- 6 Set up a local radio/Television show to tackle violence against women including harassment, teenage pregnancy, domestic violence, forced marriage, etc.
- 7 Support girls and women by providing information on services available to survivors of violence. Be a positive resource for women and girls close to you by sharing information and making referrals.
- 8 Talk to everyone around you, neighbours, friends, colleagues, about the negative social norms that justify violence against women and girls.
- 9 Use the power of social media to end violence against women and girls: use videos, pictures, social media, to mobilize public support.
- 10 Write about the prevalence of Violence against women and girls on a blog, local newspaper, university paper, etc. Write about our Regional Campaign on Zero Tolerance for Violence Against Women and Girls (**Read more**).
